Mission

Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc. (Ridgeback Rescue) is a non-profit, charitable organization dedicated to the rescue, care, and adoption of Rhodesian Ridgeback dogs in need throughout the USA and Canada. It is an all-volunteer organization that includes breeders, owners, and other devotees of the breed. Ridgeback Rescue was established under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code.

Ridgeback Rescue is the official rescue program of the US and Canadian national breed clubs, as well as most local and regional clubs. It is comprised of a network of dedicated volunteers across both countries, and operates under an established set of Rescue Policies.

Ridgeback Rescue endeavors to assist all Rhodesian Ridgeback owners in raising happy, healthy dogs by providing information about the breed and assisting with training and care throughout a dog's life.

Rescue Program

Rescue...

Ridgeback Rescue accepts ownership of unwanted, neglected, and abused Ridgebacks. They are surrendered to Ridgeback Rescue by their owners, animal shelters and humane societies, and other persons. Ridgeback Rescue provides rescued dogs with food, care, and shelter until adoptive homes can be found. They become part of the *Msaada* family of rescued dogs.

Care...

Ridgeback Rescue volunteers evaluate the health, temperament, and other characteristics of rescued Ridgebacks to determine their suitability and preparedness for placement in an adoptive home. Based upon this assessment, Ridgeback Rescue prepares dogs to the extent necessary before going to their new families. Preparation is accomplished through behavioral and obedience training, as well as arranging for veterinary care.

Adoption...

Ridgeback Rescue makes every effort to place "the right dog with the right home." Local Rescue Coordinators seek out prospective adopters for our *Msaada* Ridgebacks. Coordinators evaluate each adoption applicant to determine their suitability and preparedness for owning a rescued Ridgeback. This evaluation can include interviews, home visits, and reference checks. Ownership of a *Msaada* Ridgeback is transferred to adopters that have been approved during the

Msaada...

The "kennel" name used by Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc. for its "family" of rescued dogs. *Msaada* means "aid, assistance, help, or support" in the Swahili language. Adopters who choose to obtain ILP (AKC) or PEN (CKC) numbers to enter their rescue dogs in performance events are encouraged to register them using the *Msaada* kennel name.

application process. An adoption fee is collected to help defray costs incurred while a dog was under Ridgeback Rescue's care. Ridgeback Rescue provides continuing support and education to adopters in the form of information about the breed, care, and training throughout a dog's life.

Rescue Policy

The Rescue Policy was adopted by Ridgeback Rescue at its inception for the purpose of defining the organization's mission, and providing Rescue Coordinators and other volunteers with guidelines and parameters for their activities. The policy has served the organization and the breed well since that time. The Board of Directors periodically reviews and considers amendments to the policy to ensure that it remains viable and reflects the current needs of the breed. The entire policy is reprinted here....

MISSION

RHODESIAN RIDGEBACK RESCUE, INC. ("Ridgeback Rescue") shall maintain and support a network of rescue volunteers. The primary goal of Ridgeback Rescue is to provide for the rescue, care and rehoming of abandoned and unwanted Rhodesian Ridgebacks, as well as to protect and preserve the integrity and welfare of the Rhodesian Ridgeback breed.

LEADERSHIP

- ❑ The Ridgeback Rescue Leadership Team shall be comprised of a National Rescue Director, Assistant National Rescue Directors, a Canadian National Rescue Coordinator, and Regional and Local Rescue Coordinators.
- ❑ The National Rescue Director, Assistant National Rescue Directors, Canadian National Rescue Coordinator, and Regional and Local Rescue Coordinators shall all be members in good standing of either the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of the United States, Inc. ("RRCUS") or the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of Canada ("RRCC").
- ❑ The National Rescue Director, Assistant National Rescue Directors, and Canadian National Rescue Coordinator shall be appointed by the Board of Directors.
- ❑ Regional Rescue Coordinators shall be appointed by any one of the Assistant National Rescue Directors, Canadian National Rescue Coordinator, or National Rescue Director.
- ❑ Local Rescue Coordinators shall be appointed by any one of the Regional Rescue Coordinators, Assistant National Rescue Directors, Canadian National Rescue Coordinator, or National Rescue Director.
- ❑ The Leadership Team shall provide support and guidance to the volunteers of Ridgeback Rescue, and shall ensure compliance with all Ridgeback Rescue policies and procedures.
- ❑ It is desirable, but not required, for Ridgeback Rescue volunteers that are not part of the Leadership Team to be members in good standing of RRCUS or RRCC.
- ❑ All Ridgeback Rescue volunteers shall conduct rescue activities in accordance with the policies and procedures of Ridgeback Rescue, and shall conduct themselves in accordance with the RRCUS or RRCC Codes of Ethics.

ELIGIBILITY FOR RESCUE

Ridgeback Rescue shall rescue Rhodesian Ridgebacks in need, in accordance with the policies and procedures of Ridgeback Rescue.

BREEDER NOTIFICATION AND RESPONSIBILITY

- ❑ Ridgeback Rescue shall make every effort to notify RRCUS- and RRCC-member breeders of any Rhodesian Ridgebacks known to be of their breeding that enter the rescue program. It is the expectation of each RRCUS, RRCC, and Ridgeback Rescue that RRCUS- and RRCC-member breeders shall take possession of these dogs and assume full responsibility for their rescue, care and re-homing.
- ❑ In the event that a RRCUS- or RRCC-member breeder does not accept full responsibility for the rescue, care and re-homing of a Rhodesian Ridgeback of their breeding that enters the rescue program, Ridgeback Rescue shall assume that responsibility. In these cases, RRCUS, RRCC, and Ridgeback Rescue shall require that the breeder provide financial and other assistance to Ridgeback Rescue for the dog's rescue, care and re-homing.
- ❑ Ridgeback Rescue shall report to the RRCUS and RRCC Boards of Directors all known RRCUS- and RRCC-member breeder dogs, respectively, that enter the rescue program.
- ❑ Ridgeback Rescue may or may not, in its sole discretion, notify non-RRCUS and non-RRCC-member breeders of any Rhodesian Ridgebacks known to be of their breeding that enter the rescue program.

RESCUE EFFORTS

- ❑ The health and temperament of all rescued dogs shall be evaluated by qualified Ridgeback Rescue representatives to determine their eligibility and suitability for placement with an adoptive home.
- ❑ Ridgeback Rescue shall make every effort to obtain satisfactory evidence of a dog's health condition from the party surrendering the dog. In the event this information is not available, Ridgeback Rescue shall have those dogs examined and treated, as necessary, by a licensed veterinarian acceptable to Ridgeback Rescue, for parasites, inoculations, spay/neuter determinations, and other basic and necessary health needs.
- ❑ The commitment and dog-experience level of all prospective adoptive homes shall be evaluated by qualified Ridgeback Rescue representatives to determine their eligibility and suitability to receive a rescued dog.
- ❑ Ridgeback Rescue shall make every effort to place "the right dog with the right home," and placements shall not be determined on a "first-come, first-served" basis.
- ❑ All rescued dogs shall be spayed or neutered before an adoption is considered complete, unless the health or well-being of the dog would be threatened by such an action.

- ❑ Ridgeback Rescue-approved adoption agreements and other documentation shall be used to evidence all rescue activities conducted under the auspices of Ridgeback Rescue, whether by a group, club, individual volunteer, or other representative or agent of Ridgeback Rescue.
- ❑ Euthanasia shall only be considered in situations where the health or temperament of the rescued dog warrants such an action.

LOCAL AND REGIONAL CLUBS AND RESCUE GROUPS

- ❑ Local and regional Rhodesian Ridgeback Clubs and Rescue Groups that choose to conduct rescue activities under the auspices and guidance of Ridgeback Rescue shall agree to abide by and operate under all Ridgeback Rescue policies and procedures.
- ❑ Local and regional Rhodesian Ridgeback Clubs and Rescue Groups shall agree to contribute to the ongoing financial support of Ridgeback Rescue.

These Rescue Policies are intended to provide a guideline for rescuing Rhodesian Ridgebacks, and do not cover all possible situations. Each rescue situation must be considered on an individual basis. When a rescue volunteer is unsure how to proceed, she/he should contact a member of the Ridgeback Rescue Leadership Team for guidance.

Note to Financial Statements

- 1. Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc.** - Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc. was incorporated in the State of Virginia, USA, on March 17, 2000. The US Internal Revenue Service granted Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc. 501(c)(3) tax-exempt, charitable organization status effective March 17, 2000. Donations to Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc. are tax deductible for US taxpayers to the extent allowed by law. Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc. is the official rescue program of the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of the United States, Inc. ("RRCUS") and the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of Canada ("RRCC"), as well as most local and regional Rhodesian Ridgeback breed clubs in the USA and Canada.
- 2. Method of Accounting** - These financial statements are presented on a modified cash basis, except for the activities of the Rescue Store (Note 4), which are presented on an accrual basis.
- 3. Transfer of Assets from Rescue Committee of RRCUS and Assumption of Operations** - Effective July 1, 2000, all of the rights, title, and interests in all of the assets, liabilities, and fund balances of the Rescue Committee of RRCUS were transferred to Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue, Inc., which then assumed operations as the official rescue program of RRCUS.
- 4. Rescue Store Income** - The Rescue Store was started in July 1999 as a source of fundraising for Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue. It sells items purchased for inventory and third-party vendor items on a commission basis. Items are generally Rhodesian Ridgeback- or dog-related. Sales are made through the Rhodesian Ridgeback Rescue web site on a mail order basis and at RRCUS National Specialty shows. All Rescue Store activities are conducted by volunteers.
- 5. Office and Administrative Expenses** - Office and administrative expenses consist primarily of insurance, postage, and telephone expenses.
- 6. Amortization of Incorporation Expenses** - Incorporation costs are being amortized over a five-year period.
